- ___ 8. recall words more easily after tracing over clay or sandpaper letters that form the words
- ___ 9. remember words more easily after writing them a few times
- ___ 10. recall words more easily after playing a game containing those words, such as bingo or dominoes
- ___ 11. recall the names of objects more easily after touching them a few times
- ___ 12. write words correctly more often after tracing over them with his/her finger
- ___ 13. recall words more easily after typing them a few times
